We apologize for being late with our newsletter. On June 28, I was admitted to the hospital in Kinston, NC, with a blocked bile duct and early Saturday morning was transferred to Greenville, NC. Because of the wide-spread infection, they did not remove the gall bladder. The doctors went down my throat to the bile duct to remove the stone and the infection. I remained in the hospital five days. I will go back July 24 to schedule the removal of the gallbladder and stent that was placed in the bile duct. Keep praying for complete healing!! Thank you for your understanding and prayers!!

Norma is doing well and recovering from an infection. The transmission on our family car went out during this time also. Jackie Elwart, and family are called of the Lord to plant a church in California, and they did their presentation in that conference.
