Dear Fellow Laborers:

I apologize for the delay in getting our prayer letter to you, but this has been a “**life-changing**” month for me!! Many of you were able to get the news of my dear wife’s home going, Sunday morning, July 5th. My daughter put it out on Facebook, and I emailed all of the Churches that gave me their email addresses, and I sent texts to the Churches that had that capability. I am sure that many of you are hearing the news, in this prayer letter, for the first time.

All of you were aware of her declining health over the past two years. However, she had to go in and out of the hospital three times from mid-June until July 5th. We followed all of the COVID regulations; in place, masks, antiseptic procedures, our daughter did our shopping. Apparently, through ambulance transportation, ERs, or hospital personnel, she tested positive on her 3rd trip to the hospital. All of these hospital admissions were back to back, and she never tested positive for C-19, until the last admission. She was admitted this time to the COVID ward, and remained there from Monday, until Tuesday of the second week. They sent her home under Hospice, and I took care of her until she went to be with the Lord on Sunday morning. It was a precious time of singing (me), reminiscing, and reading scripture. Then she asked me to pray the hardest prayer I have ever prayed, “Honey, ask the Lord to take me Home.” He did, one and a half days later. My daughter was not able to come inside. She could only wave and talk to Mom through the window. I have **TESTED** negative twice!!

We live-streamed the service from our home church on July 13th. The last time I checked on the video, there had been over 1300+ viewings. It is not an easy road for me now, but for Norma, it is “**Joy unspeakable and full of Glory!!**”
