Dear Co-Laborers in Christ,

It's Springtime in eastern North Carolina, and we look forward to celebrating Resurrection Day as most others celebrate Easter. I believe that when a person fully realizes that they are lost, and then understand what Christ has done so they may be saved, it will not be necessary to coax and beg them to come to Christ. The spirit of the services has improved every Sunday, especially after three guys came forward at the end of a service, two for salvation and one for rededication. These fellows prayed out loud in front of the others, and have since showed real interest in spiritual things. On the last Sunday of March, we had a especially warm service, with enthusiastic singing, liberty to preach, and we saw four come forward, two to be saved, and two rededicate their lives to the Lord. What a joy to see some tears of repentance, and seriousness about the things of God! These guys are doing their 'After Salvation' booklets, and asking questions. Glory!
- >> Pastor Jim Poelman visited with us recently, is studying to take the Instrument written exam, and will soon begin flight training here. He is going to Alaska as a missionary.
- >> Bro tore Mitchell came down to help me with the annual inspection on our Cherokee, and that was a blessing. I also had the privilege to help him with some Instrument approaches in their "new" 1968 Cessna 310.

>> It has been so wet this winter that we have not been able to work on the runway extension, but now that conditions are improving we will get back at that project. Speaking of projects, the Lord I feel has chosen this time to complete our garage here... see enclosed sheet!



Well, sorry we got so long winded..... er...written with this prayer letter.... But it all was so needful to pray about. We so appreciate your prayers for us!


