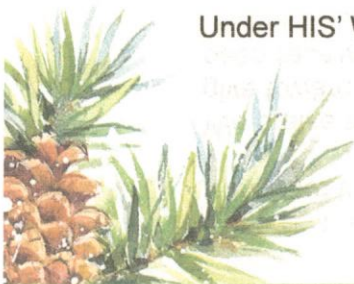

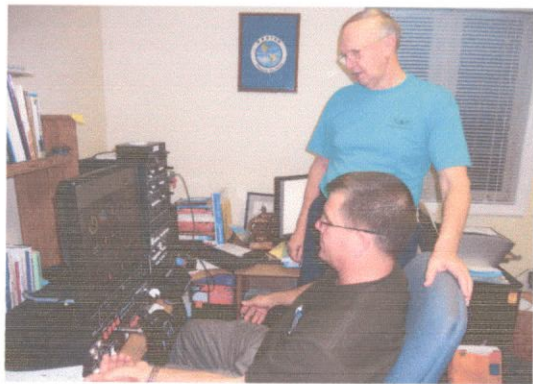

Giving Flight Training and Praying for Hangar Replacements



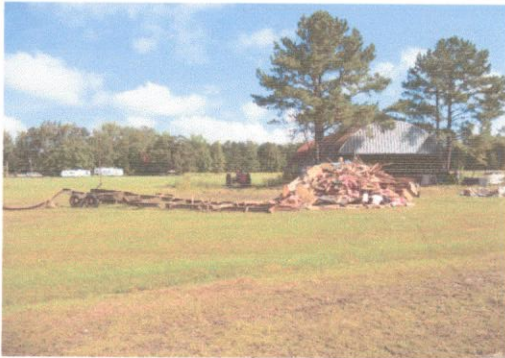
Tyler Nikkel, missionary to Papua New Guinea, receiving flight training . . .
