Dear Co-Laborers in Christ,


January-February 2013

We felt we were almost there, but we found out... 1) That concrete has greatly increased in price... and 2) That our county is charging us \$1,024.00 for the building permit. Because of this we will still need at least \$11,000 to place these two hangars into place. So trust the Lord with us, pray with and for us, and we will see what God can do! We are already anticipating the answers and blessings, and looking forward to sharing the good news with you dear folks!

Other news and blessings: We are finishing two inspections on aircraft, doing some flight training, and being visited by some of our special friends and fellow missionary pilots. Yesterday was quite unusual as we spoke with seven of our missionaries in person or by phone. One is in training, another will be receiving recurrent training here soon, and I will be going out to Chattanooga, TN in the next week or so to check out another one in a new aircraft that he will use before leaving for the field of Togo, West Africa. Busy, busy, busy, and we love it! Even if it makes us older folk tired! I'm getting a bit tired now thinking about all of this!

Prayer Requests: > Pray for us! We need your prayers, asking the Lord to grant us physical and spiritual strength for the work here, and wisdom and power from on high for service. We sincerely want to see some personal fruit in our soul-winning! Unless America soon has a deep spiritual awakening, we are not going to have life in these United States anything like the years we have so enjoyed.
