God also blessed us with a sweet reunion with two families that had served faithfully here in Lighthouse Baptist Church. They are all doing well, and are still serving the Lord faithfully. It was a blessing to renew the fellowship, and share what the Lord is doing in our lives.

The folks of Lighthouse Baptist Church abundantly blessed us with a great surprise when we arrived. Brother Sean Quinlan and some of the folks from the church met us at the airport. They drove us to the house that we had reserved in Merizo. Upon arrival, instead of finding a house with some sort of sleeping arrangement and a table and chairs, we found a couch and love seat that had been donated by one of the members.
