We are especially burdened for some who attend fairly regularly and yet have not come to the Lord for salvation.

To see the folks that are at least willing to sit under the preaching of the Word of God and learn the truth about God and His plan of salvation, where some thought this to be a hopeless endeavor, is a testimony to the grace and power of our God. We praise His dear name and give Him thanks every day.

God has blessed us and the entire island of Guam concerning His protection from the storms. This past week He made it very evident. We are known by some as "typhoon alley." For the past few weeks, we have seen tropical systems form near the Mariana Islands and move on westward. One system and its affects sent us over 30 inches of rain. Last week, another system formed to the north then moved southward past us by over one hundred miles then turned northwestward just brushing us with some blustery winds and some more rain.
