God has opened some opportunities for me here. Of course, we witness for the Lord as we go. Our home church has allowed some opportunities to serve a little for our Lord. Occasionally, we have the blessing of speaking in the college chapel. We have been asked to help with the public school children's ministry. Soon we will begin making some audio messages for the Bible college. Of course, I am trying already to provide some service with our mission by writing some articles and offering to help other missionaries in a Barnabas capacity. Finding the time and the ability to concentrate for that can be challenging, but I thank God and our mission family for affording the opportunity. Being a housekeeper and a caretaker does not leave much freedom. It is my first responsibility, and I must do my best to fulfill that.

We are hoping to venture out more in some meetings in the coming weeks and months as the Lord provides open doors. We wouldn't try long-distance meetings at first, but I believe Doris can handle some not-too-far trips. We have already had a few meetings in the past months in the hundred-mile range.
