We are thankful for the help that we receive from hospice and from the lady that comes five days to help with Doris. It gives me some time to run errands and take care of business. She comes four hours each of those days. Our precious children are footing the bill on that.

Another item that we are thankful for is the stability of Doris' vitals. Though her Alzheimer's is still slowly but steadily declining, the insurance qualifications for the hospice service is based on her vitals. We therefore have received notice that unless there is a change, Doris will be discharged from the hospice service sometime in March. This will add some workload on us, but we know the Lord will sustain and provide. We are doing some checking on the possibility of some other service covered under the insurance. Thank you all so much for your prayers and support.

I long to be able to tell you about some service in the fields of harvest, however, my number one assignment now is to take care of Mamma. I realize that it has been lengthy, but God sees fit so far to keep Doris here despite the predictions of the medical folks. We are thankful for the blessing of having Mrs. Smiles with us. In a few more weeks, we both will add another number to our ages. It seems unreal to me that I have been on this earth for nearly 85 years, and we have been a team for 62 years. God has blessed us and allowed us to serve Him as missionaries for forty-three years.

God's grace has sustained us through trials, but He has brought some glory to Himself and allowed us to see it.

Our tracks have been in many places here in the states and in the northern islands of the Pacific. We miss the folks and the places, but thankfully some of them still communicate with us and pray for us.
