Doris had a soft fall getting out of bed, and the men blessed in helping get her up and back in her chair. Thankfully, there was no injury. It was a blessed time, especially on my birthday, 86 years. God is so good with these precious friendships.

As for our physical condition, our Lord has kept us going. Doris is back on hospice service. Her physical condition is about the same. There is a gradual weakening mentally due to Alzheimer's disease. However, she is still smiling and still being cared for by her old husband. Just this week, we were surprised to have contracted the covid. Elwood got it started. We have no idea where it joined us, but since Elwood is the caretaker, it was soon joined by Doris. Our sweet daughter came to help with Doris. Linda had the shots and the boosters, but the covid managed to overcome the vaccine and boosters. Thankfully, we could get Doris in the hospice house for one week due to the hospice services, which allowed Elwood to catch up a bit. We are slowly gaining on the covid, and hopefully, we will be back to normal soon. Thank you for praying.
