Elwood is still doing pretty good for 87 years of age by the good grace of God. I have a bit of issues with my knees, mostly from wear. They have walked many miles and carried a good bit of weight. I thank God for His grace and the measure of health He has blessed me with. I am thankful for some help from the hospice service.

It is a real blessing and encouragement to hear from folks that we have served with or ministered in their lives. One of those blessings came in a social network message last week. A young man that we knew through his father in Guam contacted us. We were blessed to see his father trust Jesus as Savior. His father was terminally ill, and this young man was five years old. His father died, and we were able to connect him with another Christian family. He is now a sergeant in the Marine Corps. In his message, he expressed gratitude for our help and stated that if it were not for us, he did not know where he would be. There have been others who call us or communicate otherwise. When we follow God's leading, He can bless us with fruit that glorifies Him and gives us great joy. Praise His precious Name.

Please continue in prayer for both of us. Pray for me as I labor in caring for Doris and take care of the regular responsibilities.
