Doris is still slowly but surely sliding into the control of the Alzheimer's net. Her eating is more or less sporatic. She, at times, can fast for two days and then eat a few meals. Her weight is now at 90 pounds. She is sleeping more now. There are occasional times that she can go to bed at a normal time and wake up the next afternoon. When she is awake, she is able to sit in a wheelchair and enjoy some entertainment. Of course, she does not speak anymore. It gets interesting to determine what she wants to eat or do. She is totally immobile.

With all the handicaps, I still enjoy her fellowship and her sweet smile. It makes me so very thankful for the 65 years that God has blessed us with. On April 21, she will be 85 years of age.

Elwood is still blessed by the Lord to be able to be a caretaker for Doris. Since she is in hospice care, I have some help bathing five days a week. A nurse attends her for vitals twice a week. I am having some difficulty with my knees. I have just been blessed with the removal of fluid in one knee and cortisone in both knees. At present, I am without pain and very thankful to be so at almost 88 years old. GOD IS GOOD!

Again, thank you all so very much for your prayers and for standing with us through this journey. I still miss and dream of the islands and the people, and I get to be a testimony to the folks who tend to Doris.
