While meeting with Gaspar, he readily accepted Christ as his savior. We were delighted to see him at church two Sundays ago but missed him this week. Pray for Gaspar as we reach out to him that he would be faithful.

The kids are well and full of energy. Judson just started K5, Sammy and Noah are continuing in their efforts to play all day and Valiana is already rolling and scooting around! They love the kitty and are finally not deathly afraid of their puppy. It is great to see the kids eager to help when we get to church.
