School year 2015 did really close with a BIG BANG (We don't believe in that theory). Our dear long-time pastor friend, Jeff Fain from Cold Spring, Kentucky was our graduation guest speaker. He brought some of his church members who are interested in missions. There were at least five hundred plus in attendance. We had six tents set up alongside the procession route and had 300 chairs set up. During the graduation people were standing outside the tents three rows deep. PRAY for the salvation of the lost who were there and heard the clear presentation of the Gospel from Pastor Fain, as well as the 19 power points, interspersed with the gospel message.

Our plan for rebuilding our badly rusting and leaking 40 years old church building seems to be progressing. We met each other on Majuro when he came to build the Christian school building and parsonage there. Once I read one of his prayer letters and saw his many projects, I immediately emailed him about our proposed project.
