The Lord gave me the strength to visit my daughter and her husband in Scotland, they have been missionaries there nearly 10 years and we are so grateful for all the Lord is doing in their lives. I was privileged to preach at Solway Baptist Church in Dumfries Scotland and help minister to those in their church. What a Blessing.

Our India ministry continues through support and special offerings towards works in India and we are so happy to know these works are still going and the financial support we send helps with the continuation of all the works we have started there.

In October I started having some more concerning health issues and over the last 2 months I have been to

the ER about 5 times. Our bodies age and we just have issues beyond our control. I went for a check on my liver and the doctor said that the cancer was still there, and that the other doctor had misspoke. Thankfully it is shrinking and they will check again in the new year. We're so thankful for you and your prayers. Loretta has had a few surgeries this year she had a cyst removed and we're thankful it isn't cancer, she also had her appendix removed and again we are thankful for the Lord keeping her. She is still recovering from those surgeries, but we are thankful she is doing much better.

We are currently with our daughter in Minnesota for Christmas and the New Year and will be preaching Sunday school at the church she attends. The Lord is faithful to allow me to continue with the ministry and he gives me the strength to continue on. I ask that you pray for us, in our health, strength and ministry.
