We have met a couple of saved men in the market, who are so glad to see me that they grab me and hug me with tears in their eyes. One told me to pray for him, so we just had a good prayer meeting right there in the market where he was working.

He has been coming faithfully Sunday and listening carefully to the messages and asking me alot of questions. I know he listens because he talks to me about what I have preached. Next week, Feb 19 - 25, we will be returning to Catania for a few days. While there we will be visiting some of the dear believers that we have ministered to for some years and be in the services at Chiesa Battista Calvario for the morning services and return to Mazara del Vallo for the evening services.
