Dear Friends,

I would like to share a verse with you that made me stop and think. I believe the farther we go down life's pathway the more we realize how we fall short on wisdom and understanding. Proverbs 3:13 "Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and getteth understanding." Wisdom comes by simply asking god. But understanding comes by studying His Word. Verse 14 shows us the value of it and what we gain by using it.

This will be our last update that you receive from Sicily. Our last 15 months here in Mazara del Vallo has really been a blessing. We have had a sweet spirit and Christian unity throughout the whole time. The Church doubled in attendance with the high day coming in March. One short friendship we made was with Bro. Gino Signorello, who was saved last November and then went home to be with the Lord the day after Easter.

This being the largest shipbuilding and fishing port in Italy, our freezer has had plenty of every type of fish in it. It has been very hard to reach the fishermen because they are gone so much of the time. When they are home it is usually for a week or 10 days and then gone for another month. Two of the ladies in our church, Brigida and Lina,

have husbands which are fishermen which are not yet saved. We ask that you please pray for Andrea and Matteothat they will come to know the Lord as their personal Saviour.

Once a month we travel over to Catania to visit the Church and the people that we ministered to for many years as well as for me to make my monthly visit with the Doctor. As we were traveling back to Mazara del Vallo we were involved in a accident with very unusual circumstances. As we were coming out of a curve, I saw a SUV headed right into me with a police car chasing in behind the stolen SUV. I swerved to the right as much as I possibly could, but the SUV hit me the same, but thank God, not head on. The accident did quite a bit of damage to the car, but thank God we were not hurt. As we were in the police station making the report, we were really amazed at the help they were to us. They even brought us lunch to eat and kept asking us if we were alright. We are very thankful for the Italian Police in the city of Caltanissetta for their kindness to us at that time. We were also able to witness to a number of the policemen as well as giving them tracts and New Testaments. We ask that you please pray that those that received the material will come to know Christ as their personal Saviour. Also pray that the insurance company will pay off soon so we can have the car repaired before our departure date.
