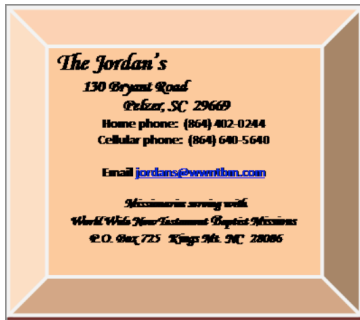


The Jordan's Update for October – November 2008
