March was a busy month as we continued our Bible Studies in the homes. I have been teaching the Book of Acts verse by verse on a weekly basis now since 2018 and we have arrived to the last chapter. The men and ladies have really enjoyed as well as learned so much and many have kept notes for their reference. Everything was going great until the Corona Virus broke out here in South Carolina. We have had to put the studies on hold for the present but plan to begin next week now that things are opening back up and no one in the houses have had contact with the Virus. One special blessing that the Lord opened up during this time of the virus is 2 Convenient stores that have fresh sandwich's, hot biscuits, and fruit cups every morning that they have to sell by 10:00am and what they don't sell they give us for the houses and the homeless. We make deliveries Monday - Saturday and these dear men and ladies really appreciate them with all their hearts. It's such a blessing what the Lord does even when we don't expect Him to use us in this way, but we have been able to share the Word of God in a different way during this time and they have seen the Love of God in another way other than just the Bible Studies.

We will continue to take the food daily as we begin the studies May 11. Pray that the new ones that have enter the homes will be open to the teaching of the Word of God in the weekly studies. If anything good that came out of this pandemic it was seeing a precious soul saved. We saw Jeffery Bagwell accept Christ as his Saviour April 12. To God Be All The Glory!! The first question he asked me was What Do I Do Now? We gave him a Bible and told him to read it every day and pray and he agreed to come to Church with us as soon as things are back to normal.
