Our Church had a Jubilee in October with two different preachers. I was able to bring some of the men every night. Two young boys were saved. Others coming to the alter for various reasons. I also was able to attend a men's fellowship in Cayce, SC, called Men4Christ.

Our health is very good, but still make routine doctors visits.. with the same words, "Come back in 6 months"
