Dear praying churches, family and friends,
Guten Tag, I have so much to share with you regarding the past few months. I'll try to be brief as I share the blessings of God. We've been praying for two specific girls in my children's church since last summer. One of the girls was saved in January, and Camilla was saved in March after Children's church and then met with me in April regarding baptism. She was baptized the next Sunday in the Laaber River. That Sunday morning, I asked Camilla if she was willing to get up in children's church to share the testimony of salvation and she was eager to do so. She did a great job and it was such a joy to see the other children's joy and excitement over her salvation. It still brings tears to my eyes as I remember.

This year in children's church our theme is "Serve Him to Know Him". Each week, I ask the question, 'How did you serve God this week?' You would be May 2024
 amazed at the answers I get from them. They are witnessing to friends, reading their Bibles, praying, singing praises to God, and then there's little 4 year old Melody "I tried to obey my mommy this week."


My parents came to visit in April for the first time since before the pandemic. It was very nice to have them here. Mom taught our ladies meeting for April and was a huge blessing. She also taught for me in children's church and the children loved her. They couldn't believe that she was a grandma and still teaching. She's actually a great-grandma but I didn't want to confuse them too much. Dad preached at both the German church Freie Baptisten Gemeinde in Oberpfraundorf and Ansbach Baptist Church for Pastor Radank.

In March, I went by train to Romania to visit our missionaries the Pricops to work on our VBS plans with
 them. We are going to have a missionary themed VBS this year and the Pricops are going to be our highlighted missionaries. It was an

amazing experience, and while I was there, I was blessed to be able to teach the gypsy children's church with Mia translating.

We had our annual joint service with Freie Baptisten Gemeinde and Ansbach Baptist Church a few weeks ago and it was an amazing service. We had around 200 people attend and my sister Julia and I taught the children's class. I actually translated her object lesson from German into English.

There are a lot of things going on this year at Hohenfels Baptist Church in the ladies and children's ministries. Please pray that we will be able to be a blessing to our community, that through these ministries we will see ladies and children saved and grow in the Lord.

Deputation update: It looks like I will be coming back to the United States for 2 weeks of furlough and 6 weeks of deputation beginning the middle of December. I am currently working on building up a schedule of visiting churches. I am hoping to be able to spend most of those Sundays visiting new churches to raise support and the Wednesday evenings visiting and reporting to churches that currently support me.
