I am excited to share that we have had many visitors in recent weeks, and God has been blessing our children's ministry in a special way. We have had as many as 38 children attending children's church, which required us to divide the group into two classes. I now teach the 7-12 year olds, while another faithful lady in the church has stepped in to teach the 4-6 year olds. This has given us the opportunity to teach in a more age-appropriate manner, helping the children better understand God's Word and engage more meaningfully in the lessons. We also have a few 12-year-olds who are preparing to move up into the teen group. Over the past couple of months, I have focused on teaching them how to take notes during a church service, helping equip them to listen actively, follow the message, and apply God's Word as they transition into the next stage of discipleship.

Recently, we held a Homeschool Christmas play, which was a huge blessing. Many visitors came to watch their children and friends participate, giving us a wonderful opportunity for outreach. Our children's church also prepared a special choir presentation for the church. The children sang Christmas hymns, signed songs, played

instruments, and presented handbell specials. Teaching the handbells was the most challenging part for me, as it required consistent practice over the past three months, meeting three times a week—and I'll admit, I've been hearing the bells being jangled relentlessly! Still, seeing the children work together and joyfully offer their best to the Lord made every moment worthwhile.

Please continue to pray for wisdom, strength, and spiritual growth for the children, as well as for those who are teaching and serving. Pray that God would continue to draw families to Himself and that His Word would take deep root in the hearts of these young ones.
