May 2026

Greetings from Germany! The Lord has been very good these past few months and I wanted to share a few recent blessings and prayer requests. As I'm writing this prayer letter, one of the songs we sang in Children's Church this past Sunday keeps going through my mind, 'I love to tell the story of unseen things above, of Jesus and His glory, of Jesus and His love. I love to tell the story, because I know 'tis true; it satisfies my longings as nothing else can do.' We are blessed to be able to have the privilege to share this story with our community here in German!

Our normal ministries - teaching, discipleship, and counseling are continuing weekly and are a huge blessing. Our church continues to grow and it is amazing to see God working in the lives of our soldiers and their families here in Hörmannsdorf, Germany. A few of our ladies and I were able to go to the ladies retreat at Rhineland Baptist Church in Landstuhl and it was a great blessing and a lot of fun to spend a few days with them. We had our last homeschool classes yesterday for this school year. It was a great year. We had between 28-30 children enrolled all year and are very thankful for this outreach ministry.

Please pray for our upcoming Vacation Bible School and teen meeting (June 22-25 6pm - 8pm). I visited Corre and Claudia in Madrid in March to finalize the plans for VBS and the teen meeting. Please pray that many children and teens will attend and that the gospel will be clearly preached and received. It was amazing to be able to spend a bit of time with Corre and Claudia and experience their ministry. I don't do well in packed, crowded spaces and normally avoid them like the plague but they have grown so much over the past few years that I was standing in a corner of the room trying to stay out of everyone's way. Their people were all so sweet. As they passed by me, they would greet me with a kiss on the cheek or a pat on the arm. Thankfully, I had met one of their young couples the evening before and as she kissed me on the cheek, she explained the greeting culture or I would have been very surprised.

On Thursday evenings, the Bible study for the older children, ages 7-12, has focused on the names of God. Last Thursday night, I asked the children to share some of their favorite names for God and explain what those names mean. Some of their favorite names so far have been Abba Father, Buckler, Creator, Amen, Alive Forevermore, Alpha and Omega, and Comforter. It amazes me how much they can remember. Some of these names are from the very first lesson back in October. I especially loved their explanations. Emma (10)...said of Alpha and Omega, "He's the A to Z of life, the beginning and the ending. Georgia (7)...explained Amen by saying "Let everything thing that I've said before, happen. Let it be so, let it be true." Another one of our themes for the past 2 years has been "Serve". Last year, at the beginning of every children's church I would emphasize a way we serve the Lord

and then I would ask the children, "How did you serve the Lord this week?" This year, the emphasis has been on teaching the children specific areas of service, such as puppetry, singing, playing musical handbells, assisting the younger children in their Bible memorization, and witnessing. A few of the girls have been especially bold in their witness for Christ.
