Dear Pastors and Prayer Partners,

Our schedule is slowly getting filled. We have been to our churches in North and South Carolina, Kentucky, Tennessee, and some of our churches in Florida. We are getting ready to head to Mississippi, Louisiana, Texas, and Oklahoma. We still are trying to reach a few of you. Several churches have had to lower our support or drop us because their churches are struggling financially right now. Please pray for the churches in America. It seems that everywhere church members are not returning to church after being out for Covid. It is sad to see once-thriving churches struggling because God's children have gotten comfortable just staying at home. We have had a few new churches take us on, and we are trusting God to provide.

We are praying about when we should return to Ghana; we are tentatively planning on leaving in October. However, we may return after the New Year. We are trying to raise some additional support. When we came back to the States in September of last year, we could not get many meetings booked. Many of our churches were not having services and were not scheduling any meetings. Most of them wanted us to wait and call them after the New Year. So, the first four months or so of furlough, we were not doing much traveling, but now we are really busy trying to visit everyone that wants an update on the ministry in Ghana.

We are also working on getting the single-wide mobile home that we bought when we got married 24 years ago fixed up. It needs some work. So in between meetings, we will be working on getting it livable again. Abigail and Caleb are going to be living in it while they are in college. We are trying to keep their expenses down as much as possible so they can work and pay for college. Living there will keep them from having to pay for rent or water because there is a well on the property. Please keep them in your prayers. This is a big change for them as well as for us. They are both getting involved in the ministries at our home church, Orangeburg Baptist Tabernacle. They are singing in the choir; Caleb has been going out on visitation twice a week with our pastor. Abby is helping teach in the children's church. She is excited about helping because she taught children's church in Ghana, and she really loved it. It is encouraging to see them serving God. We are so thankful to our church for taking them under their wing and helping them adjust during this transition.

As always, we are so thankful for your prayers and support. We are glad you have chosen to partner with us to reach Ghanaians with the gospel of salvation.
