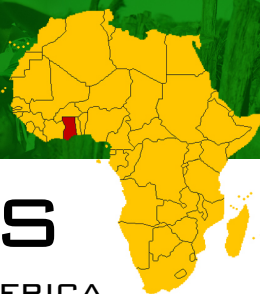




THE KENNEYS

Greetings from Ghana, West Africa! We have been back in Ghana for two weeks now. It has been crazy. It is a big process when you have been out of the country for a year. There are always many things to take care of. We had to renew our Ghana non-citizen cards, switch our phones back to Ghana service, and buy groceries and essentials. We had to get our vehicle running because it was not running when we got back. All of our dishes have to be taken out of the cabinets and washed because they are covered in dust from the dusty season. Tonya is in the process of pulling all of our clothes out of our closet and dressers because they mildewed while we were gone. She had to wipe down the closet walls and dresser drawers to remove the mildew and get rid of the musty smell. It is taking her a while because she cannot run the washer and the dryer at the same time. It will burn up the outlet. It is the rainy season, so hanging the clothes out to dry is not an option. Oh, the joys of living in Ghana! 😊

On our first Sunday back, we couldn't go to our church because the roads were so bad. The rainy season has been especially wet this year, and the roads are in terrible condition. We went to a missionaries' church near us instead. By Wednesday, the roads had dried up somewhat, and we were able to be back with our people for the prayer service. It was so good to see their faces. Everyone told us how much they missed us, and how happy they were that we were back. It was a joyful day.

The work on the wall behind our church has stopped temporarily because of the rain. The roads are so muddy that they cannot get the trucks back there to work without getting stuck. Lord willing, we will resume work on the wall in a couple of weeks. So far, the partial wall has kept the mud from sliding down the hill into the church. Thank you once again to those who gave for this project. We really appreciate it.
