We exchanged contact information and visited them a few days later to see how we could encouraged this struggling family. We thank the Lord for allowing us to cross paths with this young family to help them spiritually. We will be working on Julie's visa renewal this month and are praying for no complications with the Burkina Faso embassy. Our departure will be out of Atlanta, GA on Sunday 10th of August 2014 at 2:27 p.m. Please help us pray as we will need to make preparations to bring our luggages to the airport and coordinate airport trips with people we know. We praise the Lord for providing a travel agent that helped us get a good deal on our tickets. We are still waiting for information on how to handle and process the extra luggages we plan to bring with us on the plane. Please pray that every thing would go smoothly as we process this information and make proper arrangements.

Family Time in Canada

Currently in Canada, we are spending time with Julie's family and praise the Lord for several opportunities to share the Gospel and what we believe from God's word with them. We praise the Lord for the opportunities we have had to be a good example for our Lord. For the first time, family members did not try to stop spiritual conversation, but gladly encouraged it and asked us many spiritual questions. We even asked to pray before meals, and Julie's mother and her boyfriend gladly joined in with us. We also had the privilege to visit a church plant in Edmundston, NB on our first Sunday in Canada. The missionary and his team who planted the church were once missionaries in the Ivory Coast. It was encouraging to see that although God unexpectedly changed their direction in ministry, they were faithful and continued in the work He had set for them, leading to this specific church plant. Julie and I have been praying for a church to be started in Havre-St-Pierre, QC where Julie's father works. God has answered our prayer with Church Planter Wes Burns, who arrived last year with a burden for the North shore of Quebec. It was a joy for me to help with the distribution efforts of the Gospel in this area. Please pray for the Church in Havre-St-Pierre. So far, we have 74 supporting Churches. We began full-time deputation at the beginning of the month of September 2012, and completed raising our finances in May of 2014. Praise God for allowing us to complete deputation under two years!



Our traveling has led us through 36 different States, Puerto Rico, 2 Provinces of Canada, and the Country of France, totaling at over 73,000 driven miles. Out of the 36 States we have traveled through, 22 of them have at least one of our supporting Churches.
