Their keeping up with our house while we were gone was a tremendous blessing to our family upon our return. We are thankful that most of every thing was found the way it was left, if not better. Miraculously, our chickens are still living, our plants are green and growing, our guards stayed at their post, and our house is mold free. It has been wonderful to get back into a daily work schedule and into our weekly routine, especially for our darling daughters.

Progress in our absence

It was a joy to see the church members still attending church when we got back! We had 4 first time visitors on our first Sunday home and two have returned the following Sunday. We are greatly encouraged to see the church's progress in our absence. This is especially true for Aimé and Bienvenu who were given the big responsibility of studying and teaching these last three and half months. These two young men have worked together to encourage and keep the excitement within the church activities and they are a great encouragement to me. They have also shown incredible maturity, improvement, and boldness in their speaking since we left. In addition to teaching during the church gatherings, Bienvenu completed a discipleship series with Blaise. We also found out that Blaise has completed his Bible reading plan in May, which means that he read through the Bible in five months. Christine also faithfully held monthly women's meetings and taught lessons to the ladies in attendance. Her and Judith even worked together to teach how to bake a cake without an oven!
