I visited the family to present my condolences and the catholic family shared with me that since Arnaud had been coming to our church, he had been regularly reading the Bible that we had given him. Please pray for the salvation and consolation of Arnaud's family. Please pray for Vincent to be serious in his decisions for the Lord.
