Construction Progress

This last month, we installed the sample door and window that is going to be used for the whole property. This is an encouraging step as we now have a closed room where we keep construction equipment on site instead of transporting it back and forth from our house.

At the end of the month, we successfully poured the last foundations for the church auditorium. So far, we are right on track to move to the new location before the end of November. We are spending extra time working on the construction site to reach this goal. Please pray there would be no complications during the dismounting and reassembling of the church building. Help us pray for the installation of city water and electricity. We were able to get the ball rolling with those two needs and are praying that they would be installed in the upcoming weeks. Individual Soul Liberty We held our annual "Why am I Baptist?"

We held our annual "Why am I Baptist?" conference. Since Burkina Faso's protestant movement is dominated by the Assembly of God church, we are often confused with them by the Muslims and Catholics. Most who attend an Assembly of God church do not know the differences between their beliefs and the Baptist convictions. Therefore, we take the time, once a year, to highlight what makes "Baptist" beliefs different from the protestant movement. This year, the Lord led me to underscore the distinctive of "Individual Soul Liberty." I asked a Burkinabé pastor from a Baptist church in the northern part of the country to be our keynote speaker. There were around 70 people in attendance, many of whom thanked me for this informative and helpful meeting.

Since the theme of the conference was "Prayer", she taught on prayer and was was able to use many examples of answered prayers we have personally experienced in our lives to encourage the ladies. 
2020 Furlough Scheduling
