Covid-19 infection

A few days after Julie's arrival from Delaware, we were informed that numerous individuals with whom she had close contact had tested positive for Covid-19. Julie began to experience symptoms of the virus a few days later, after which time she tested positive for the virus as well. We proceeded to quarantine our family for the recommended amount of time. This led to our first in person meeting for furlough being cancelled so that we could contain the virus. We praise the Lord that after a period of social isolation, no one else in our household developed symptoms. Julie is recovered, and this sickness has not affected her breathing or the baby. We have now tested negative for the Corona virus and will resume travels the first week of September.
