Julie's Citizenship

Julie, being a Canadian citizen with a US residency card, has recently satisfied all the requirements for US naturalization. She can now submit all the final paperwork and wait for biometric and interview appointment dates to be given to her to finalize her American citizenship status. Under her current green card status, she could only leave America for 12 months at a time, and had to continually re-file for an absence permit, every year, in person and in a stateside immigrations office, before the expiration date of the last yearly permit. For this very complicated reason, we know it is best to apply for citizenship so that she will not have to always come back to America on a yearly basis to renew paperwork. Please pray that these citizenship appointements would be made as early as possible, that the lawyer working on her case would be efficient in every aspect of the application process, and that the whole ordeal would be done without delays.
