Returning to Burkina Faso

We are also awaiting certain documents for the kids and Julie before we can all travel as a family. Translation project

Our sending church has a ministry called School of the Bible which is designed for "strengthening local churches and the community through education by providing additional systematic Bible and ministry training designed for laypeople." I am excited to report that I am translating the last course and will be done before my return to Burkina.
