

As I have been able to get back in the swing of the routine in Burkina Faso, it was exciting to spend time with Adama to see how his faith has stood firm amidst several difficulties that he has faced. We have resumed discipleship time together and I am pleasantly surprised by the way he interacts with the other men of the church. He feels like he belongs with the folks of the church and that was perhaps the most encouraging sight to witness considering that past schism that took place. Adama has almost completed the new members class and will soon be added to the active membership of the church. Continue praying for Adama as he continues to read the Bible with his neighbors and friends. There have been some new people attending his Bible study.



Pastoral training with Omar

When I returned to Burkina Faso, I found that although Serge was still faithful, his desire to be in the full-time ministry was not the same. As Bienvenu, he wants to be involved, but leading is something that he confessed was not for him. Thus, the prayer and search for a pastor continues. There was another faithful man in the church who had expressed interest in the ministry, his name is Omar, the first deacon of the church. Although his testimony is strong, he does have a low level of education that would handicap him in studying and teaching the Word of God. I asked Omar if he would be willing to further his education to which he responded very positively. On the last day of October Omar went back to school and he has David as teacher. David's health has been restored and after a few days of consideration of my offer to teach Omar, he accepted. Please pray for Omar as he is going back to a middle school level program of education to take up where he had left off when he was just a child.

It is not rare for us to lead someone to the Lord and even having them express a prayer of faith in Christ, however, what is rare is to have someone actually come to church. Thankfully for the month of October, we were able to see two first time visitors from soul winning efforts. One was a friend of one of our members who finally accepted the
