Arouna's faith

In September of last year, a muslim man showed up at our Gospel tent wanting to have more information on what we were all about. He said that although he grew up in a muslim home, his father had told him that he was free to pick the religion he wanted to follow. Thus, he told me that he would like to learn more about christianity to help him see if he would be interested in adhering to a different faith. He was very receptive to the Gospel and started coming to church out of curiosity. On one of those Sunday mornings, he trusted Christ as his Savior. He is entirely new to the christian faith and it is thrilling to see him discover the Bible. At the end of last year, I asked him if he would be interested in one-on-one bible studies and he said yes. We began in January and our meetings are going very well. He was discouraged because he finally had the courage to inform his father that he had become a christian, and although his father had given him the liberty to pick the religion of his choosing, he did not respond well to that information. Please pray for Arouna's faith as he begins to experience opposition.

Chalenges with Tabtenga

We are continuing to meet at Tabtenga every Sunday afternoon and Wednesday evening and we are seeing a lot of visitors come and go. Unfortunately, a large number of visitor have ulterior motives for coming and that has been a challenge for this new church plant. There are about 5 men who are faithful and excited about the beginning of the church. Please pray that these men would not get discouraged as they are faced with the reality that not everybody shares their same desire to walk with God.
