Because of this tragedy, Valentin's father made the hard decision to flee the village for the safety of his wife and two daughters. When Valentin told me of this development, we were heart broken and quickly thought of what we could do to aid this family who had lost so much and had no where to live. Valentin's family was able to find a bus to get to Ouagadougou, the capital city, where we picked them up and

arranged for them to stay in a rental property where they can have a roof over their heads. Please pray for the Kantagba family as they acclimate to city life and as we strive to encourage them in the Lord. Please also pray that security would be restored in their region so that they may return home.
