Pray for Melodie as she has started her final semester of LPN school. We are grateful to God for the many ways that He has met our needs exceedingly abundantly more than we asked. There have been dozens of needs that God so graciously met that we brought before Him in prayer and He either provided more directly or He moved the hearts of others to help us in our travels. Pray for safety as we drive and fly these coming months to meetings. Finally, pray with us that the Lord will provide the last 30% of our support. It is almost surreal to think that we are this close to heading out to the Solomons. God has been so good to us. He has rescued us from our own sinfulness in pursuing the vanity of this world that our eyes may be set on the kingdom to come and His glory. Our days spent here on this terrestrial ball are numbered by His hand and we would all do well to consider the work that God has called each of us to perform.
