



MISSIONARIES TO THE SOLOMON ISLANDS

Prayer letter for November and December 2025

Dear Friends,

The past two months have truly been among the most difficult thus far. Living in the Solomon Islands can feel pretty isolated from friends and family as well as the rest of the culture that I grew up in. In November, I sent Melodie and the children back to the US for medical checkups with the coming baby. In doing so, I sent away my greatest companion which was extremely difficult. I reunited with my family in



Kansas the second week of January, and will be here for almost 2 months to be with Melodie as she delivers our baby girl, Lottie. I am very grateful to be together with my wife and children. The return date for the whole family is set for the middle of March. A convert from our ministry is looking after the church with the assistance of a Pastor from PNG.

During the month of November and December, we continued with Sunday services, outreach, and Bible studies. The open air Bible study in the beetle-nut market is going well. I preach every Tuesday and Thursday morning for 1 hour. The people seem well receiving to the preaching and have begun turning off the loud music when I start. Several good contacts have been made and personal Bible studies

scheduled. We have been notified of a large shipment of about 1,000 bibles coming our way. The church will do an outreach at the market for the distribution of these Bibles.

We are in the process of building our house and things are going smoothly. We have the concrete posts up, timber framing and a metal roof installed.

The people of Auki Baptist Church are looking for land that we can build a permanent location on. Pray that God would enable the people here to be able to meet their need. We do ask that you do not donate to this cause, it is very important that the majority of the process is done by the people here. Some funds have been given already and they should suffice.



Pray for Melodie and the ladies of the church, because of Melodie's absence all of her ministry's have been set aside while she has been in the US. This has left a large hole and I know she is excited to start them all again but there will be much work.

Pray for our son Douglas (age 5 in February), he has been asking a lot of really searching questions about God and the gospel. Pray for wisdom on our behalf in evangelizing our son. George (age 2) is doing well. He has started using full sentences. He, along with Doug are extremely excited to meet their baby sister. They both had been praying for a sister for a while and took her coming as an answer from God. Do continue to pray for Melodie and baby Lottie as she is close to deliver.
