that work in our city. One of these men, named Renato, was quite interested in why we were here in Brazil; thus, he invited Jeremy and Jedediah (our trusty translator) to his house. Before we left that day, Renato said he wanted to be saved and told us he was now trusting only in Jesus Christ as his Savior rather than his Catholic saints. The next week we had Renato and his family over to our home and were able to witness to his wife as well. However, after our first few visits with Renato, we have been unable to keep regular contact to continue teaching the Scriptures. He lives over a 30 minute drive from us and doesn't seem to want to answer the phone lately, but we are praying that we would be able to regain contact with him and be able to make sure that he truly understood the Gospel that day, and if so that we we would see him grow in the Lord.
