As spring blooms, we stand in awe of God's faithfulness and your steadfast partnership. Your prayers and sacrificial giving empower us to serve our missionary families, and we're excited to share how God has moved these past two months. March was a season of travel and encouragement. Jeremy attended the funeral for the mother of one of our missionary families, offering support in their grief. We visited a missionary planting a deaf church, marveling at the phenomenal work God is doing to reach this precious community. Jeremy preached a mission conference at a supporting church in North Carolina, urging believers to embrace the Great Commission. We also spent time encouraging a missionary widow in her season of loss. A trip to California brought Jeremy and several board members to a sending church for a missionary interview with a new candidate headed to Brazil. At WWNTBM, we travel to these churches to connect with pastors and congregations, showing them we exist to serve them and their missionary, not the other way around. Jeremy also preached a Sunday in Nevada and a missions weekend in Florida, pleading for laborers for the harvest.

April was packed with ministry and milestones. At the home office, we met with a bank representative for administrative tasks and with See The Harvest leadership to plan upcoming short-term mission trips that train believers in evangelism. We welcomed a national missionary from the Middle East, driving him to churches for three weeks of meetings to help raise support for his vital work. In the midst of these meetings, we finalized preparations for and held our busiest yet most rewarding event: Family Fellowship Week (FFW). About 130 people gathered—missionaries on furlough or deputation, board pastors, and over 50 missionary kids who enjoyed their own sessions, fellowship, and activities. Funded by churches who value refreshing missionary families, FFW was a triumph, with powerful preaching, heartfelt testimonies, and renewed strength for the field. After FFW, we completed the meetings and dropped our Middle East missionary at the airport to return to his field. We're also preparing for Bethany's high school graduation, a bittersweet milestone as she seeks God's next step.
