Spring Break also gave me time to plan new children's lessons for each class at church and to find new choir music. With the Lord's wisdom and help, I was able to get things planned out until summer. As pre-school resumed, I was also ready to begin enrollment for the new school year. With only two preschoolers moving forward into the four-year-old class, Momma and I have been praying about enrolling a few extra three-year-olds this year. Please pray that God will give us wisdom to enroll just the right students.

The physical and spiritual needs of the children of Grenada are great. Please join me in praying that God will continue to give us wisdom in helping to meet these needs.
