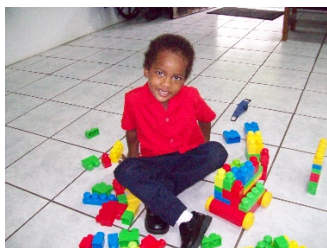
MISSIONARY TO CHILDREN OF GRENADA, WEST INDIES

September/October 2020

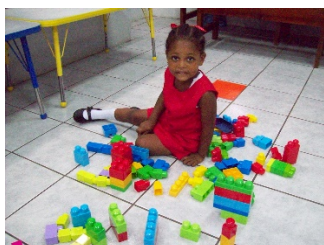
Dear Friends and Faithful Supporters,

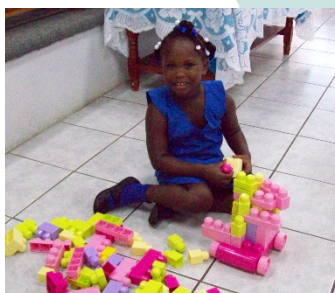
Tyrik is a lot of fun! He is struggling in this new school year after missing months of school and not having the support at home he needed.



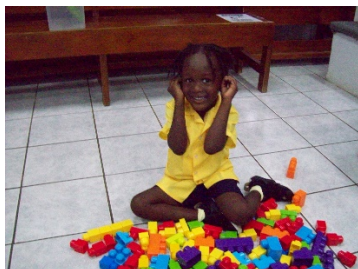

Aviah has a lot of support at home which has benefitted her academically in this pandemic, but she needs to work on patience, self-control, and not quitting when things are challenging.



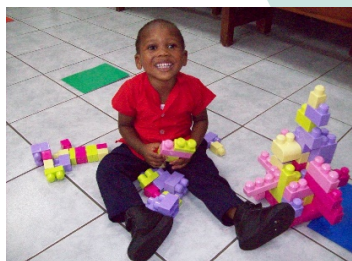
Khalif would rather stay at home which makes it challenging to teach him and to get him to do his writing and coloring.
