- 3. My parents (who are in their 70's) also need your prayers. They have been taking good care of me, but I would rather be taking care of them!
- 4. Please pray for our safety traveling to St. George (over and hour away). It has been and will be a lot of extra traveling on roads that are in very poor condition.
- 5. My insurance has said they will cover me, but as you know, they will not cover it all, and we have had a lot of added expenses at this time.
- 6. Children's attendance has been low at church the past two months. Please pray that soon I will be able to go out and to encourage the children to be faithful to church.

The Lord has given me a lot of peace at this time, and I am so thankful. I know He is in control and will continue to answer prayers. Thank-you for your continued prayers and support in this new year!
