Due to the pandemic the pre-school has also had many needs. God provided us with four tables to expand our ability to social distance and He provided the curriculum for next year. Please pray as we finish out our extended school year, re-enroll for next year, and for our parents, many of whom are not saved.

Despite many attempts, the insurance company has been unwilling to pay my medical expenses from the surgery, but God provided in an amazing way. Two churches (one of which does not even know me personally) gave large gifts which completely covered all of my expenses!

Thank-you to all who pray and give. Truly God is faithful to give back to us anything we give to others!
