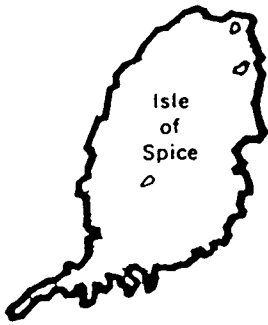

Unseasonably heavy rains have hindered maintenance on the church building, and church activities. There has been flooding and storm damage on the island but our area has been very fortunate. Between the heavy storms we were able to paint the inside and outside of the church and carry on with the activities of the ministry.

We closed out 2003 with an Old Year's Service that lasted from seven to mid-night. Robert and two of our young men preached, we had food, a film, lots of singing, dedicated ourselves to the Lord, and prayed in the New Year. The highlight of the night for the children was when we handed out noise makers. All of Loretto knew those who chose to start the New Year out right by being in God's House.

Our prayer is that you had a blessed holiday season and that you have purposed in your heart to let God use you in a greater way in 2004.
