Dear Pastor,

Thank you for your interest in missions, and especially for your support of Brother Robert Mathena. As you will note from the letters enclosed, Brother Mathena has lost support for a variety of reasons over the last several months. The Mathenas have done a commendable job in Grenada, and they continue to serve the Lord faithfully.

We all understand that things change, and sometimes it is necessary for a church to make adjustments. In rare occasions a missionary will find this repeating itself in a brief time period. Usually it will work out so that the support can be made up during furlough, but this is not always the case. Such is the situation with Brother Mathena.

There are two options when the loss of support is critical. Either the missionary must return to the States to raise support, or make an appeal to make up enough of the loss to continue until furlough time. Brother Mathena does not wish to come home. It would be his sincere desire to remain with his responsibilities in Grenada. Will you please pray about helping to make up the needed support? If his supporting churches could each increase his support a little it would certainly help to meet the need.

Your kind consideration of this very important matter is appreciated.


