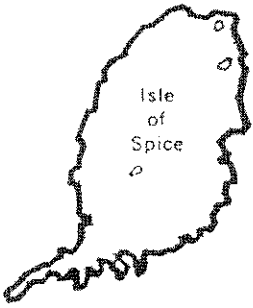

Carrie's arrival was perfectly timed to help with all the special Easter activities. She also started a Sunday morning class and special activities on Fridays for the pre-school aged children. The children are so excited about these classes and activities that they have been attending every church service. They don't want to miss anything!

Our church family has entered a season of giving. They are giving themselves to faithful attendance and involvement in the activities of the church. The second coin offering for the children's ward of the hospital was \$176.50 EC, and we have handed out twelve food baskets to the elderly in Loretto already this year.
