

Now she wants to be baptized so that all of Loretto will know she is really serious about serving the Lord. In the past she has been a real trouble maker. Ezekiel got saved and told us he was convicted about his cussing. He asked us to help him pray and with a big smile he said, "I haven't cussed in three days." Arlene was given an award in school for the best behaved student. And Kevon couldn't sleep after a Sunday night message. Each time he woke up he read his Bible and prayed. Finally he was able to sleep but he had a dream that he was preaching. Five of our teens have presented themselves for baptism in June. Keep praying for the work in Loretto and rejoice with us.

A young couple from our sending church visited us over the Easter vacation. They were seeking God's direction in their lives and came to help with a Vacation Bible School. Most of those who attended the Vacation Bible School were our faithful church family. The teens were a great help with crafts, cleaning, and anything else that was needed. Five asked the Lord to be their Saviour. It was a great week and we know the Miller's would covet your prayers as they return home and seek the Lord's will.

Because of your gifts the church in Loretto now has: a railing for the platform, communion table, a large cross for the front wall, pulpit, bulletin board, frame for the chalk board in the sanctuary, two security gates for the outside porch and fellowship hall, and a basketball goal. The basketball goal has drawn the teens and we have had four young men saved so far.
