These past three months have looked very different than how we had envisioned our arrival to the field, but God has shown us His love and faithfulness through these uncertain times. We know that all of you have been greatly affected by COVID-19, yet you have still faithfully reached out and prayed for us! The quarantine is still in



effect throughout most of Bolivia, and cases are continuing to rise. We have been in lock down for 14 weeks and suspect that it will continue for the foreseeable future. This has been such a difficult time financially for many people here, and God has opened doors for us to help the Murrays deliver food to several ministries here in Santa Cruz. Sadly, churches have not been allowed to meet since the quarantine began, but the new church plant has been able to meet together online twice per week.

Recently, we were able to locate a language tutor here in Bolivia who is willing to do lessons via Zoom. It has been great to get a jump on learning Spanish during this time of quarantine. Unfortunately, our residency paperwork is currently stalled, but we hope to continue making progress when the restrictions begin to lift.

The police ministry has continued and has grown larger than any of us would have imagined! Just last week, we were able to help the Murrays prepare gift bags for a station of 900 officers. This station has had several officers pass away due to the virus, and we are thankful to have a part in sharing the gospel during this difficult time. Please continue to pray that God will keep these doors of ministry open to show these officers God's love for them.
