This past week, she taught Shera how to make one of our favorite Bolivian dishes called Sopa de Mani (peanut soup). She is great with children and the boys have enjoyed having someone to speak Spanish with them.

This past month, God provided us with a car to lease while we search for a vehicle to purchase. We are able to keep this car through December, but we would appreciate your prayers as we begin searching for the right vehicle for our family and ministry.
