### Dear Prayer Partners and Supporters,

What a comfort to know during times of change and uncertainty that

our "God's purposes shall stand". We are coming to the end of a 3<sup>rd</sup> COVID wave here in Bolivia. Along with this new wave came a new set of restrictions and curfews. Throughout May and June, the city enforced one day lockdowns for several Sundays. Thankfully, due to a recent decline in cases, the Sunday quarantine has been lifted and services have now gone back to normal. We had hoped to host several neighborhood outreaches, including a Mother's Day lunch in May, but because of the COVID restrictions we have had to postpone these outreaches for now.

In spite of new health measures, we were able to start a Saturday kids club and there have been children from the neighborhood faithfully attending. Each week, we have a Bible lesson, songs, crafts, games, and end with a snack. We are so thankful to have the opportunity to share the gospel with these precious children each and every week.

We mentioned in our last letter that Ryland's visa had been rejected, and unfortunately, there is no news yet as to when we will have this issue resolved. Please continue to pray that God will intervene and allow his visa to be approved. We currently have an immigration lawyer working to resolve the problem and are hoping to find a solution in the next few weeks.
